



UPSKILL your workforce through TechCred

No matter your industry, technology is having an impact on the future of your business and the nature of your work. Ohio's TechCred program gives businesses the chance to upskill current or future employees to help them qualify for a better job in today's tech-infused economy.

What is TechCred?

TechCred provides funding for up to 20,000 short-term, technology-focused credentials. Employers can receive up to \$2,000 for each current or new employee who earns an industry recognized, technology-focused credential-and up to \$30,000 per funding round.

Eligible Certifications:

- CompTIA IT Fundamentals Certification
- CompTIA A+ Certification
- CompTIA Network + Certification
- CompTIA Security + Certification

April 1 - 30

The length of the grant will be reduced from 18 months to 12 months from the award date. Training programs must start on or after the date of the award, not before, and must be completed in less than 12 months. Training providers are no longer eligible to receive reimbursement for employees trained in-house. If a training provider wishes to utilize TechCred to upskill their employees, they must use an external training provider.
